For SAC'ers majoring in dance, please fill in the number of years of training and the school in which you have trained so that we can place you appropriately. If you have danced in SAC in previous summers please note whether it was for 3 weeks or 7 weeks. **Please note there are no performance classes for beginning level dancers.**

As for our New Theatre Workshop, please be aware that everyone is welcome to be in one of our summer musicals. You do not have to be a theatre major. Just be aware that rehearsals will be every morning for 3 hours so it is a serious commitment. For full summer campers, please indicate if you want to be in both Session 1 and/or Session 2 productions.

On pages 2 and 3 please number the elective courses you would like to take in order of your preference. **PLEASE NUMBER AS MANY AS POSSIBLE.** I will try to accommodate your wishes whenever possible and would love flexibility. If there is something you absolutely do **not** want please put a **NO** next to this course. However, I urge you to try new classes over the summer. It's a great time to experiment. On page 3 you should also indicate if you wish to swim and if you are interested in gymnastics.

These SAC class forms must be returned to me **NO LATER THAN APRIL 16th**. Late forms risk not getting all of your preferred choices.
