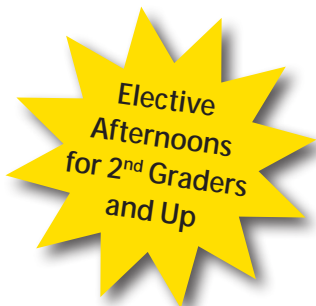

CAMP GADOL (Age 2-entering grade 4)

FUN FOR PRESCHOOLERS

Our youngest campers, 2 yrs-entering Pre-K are introduced to the day camp experience through a variety of professionally led outdoor and indoor activities including art, music, nature, water play, sports and more. Pre-K children swim in our heated pool every day. Groups are led by experienced teachers and caring staff with one counselor for every four to five children.

Children entering K-4th grade enjoy a variety of activities including swimming, sports, arts, gymnastics, martial arts, music, nature, and more, in a nurturing, non-competitive environment. Our oldest campers, entering 2nd-4th grades, also enjoy a local trip every week.

We're pleased to offer our newest program geared to older campers looking for an activity filled summer close to home. Camp Xtreme is a perfect combination of traditional day camp activities including swim, sports, nature and art, coupled with special theme weeks such as technology, science and entertainment, and includes a specialist visit and a trip every week. When on site, Xtreme campers will also have an opportunity to participate in elective afternoons, The Chosen.

CIT EXPERIENCE (Entering grades 9-10)

A BALANCE OF WORK AND PLAY FOR TEENS

The JCC CIT Experience combines hands-on counselor training with social action initiatives and weekly CIT only trips for a full, enriching summer experience. CITs spend each morning assisting in camper groups. After lunch, CITs meet to enjoy some social time with their peers. In addition to weekly trips, CITs also take one overnight trip incorporating fun with leadership training. To round out each week, CITs participate in an on or off campus social action initiative which supports local causes. CITs (entering 10th grade) who successfully complete the program may be invited back next summer as Junior Counselors. *Limited spaces available. Application and interview required.*

The Toward Tomorrow Program provides children with developmental learning needs a nurturing, learning and recreational summer experience. Half-day, full-day and inclusion options are available.

SUMMER ARTS CENTER (SAC)

(Entering grades 3-8)

UNLEASH YOUR CREATIVE TALENTS!

The joy of creative expression is what our unique Summer Arts Center is all about. The only program of its kind in lower Westchester, SAC provides an opportunity for campers to focus on art, dance or theatre as a major, while taking electives in other disciplines.

CHOOSE THE CLASSES YOU WANT

Campers create a custom schedule of four classes each day (20



classes per week), all taught by professionals in the field. Classes include drawing and painting in charcoal, water color and acrylic, decoupage, jewelry design, 3D art, video, string instrumental, classical ballet, tap, jazz, hip hop, musical theatre workshop, acting and improvisation.

New and improved instructional swim, gymnastics, and teen fitness are also offered and all campers are encouraged to participate.

At the end of the summer, all campers proudly share their artistic accomplishments in the “SAC Showcase.” Half summer campers also have a final showcase.

DANCE INTENSIVE (Entering grades 7-12)

TAKE YOUR TRAINING TO A NEW LEVEL

The serious and experienced dance student will enjoy a comprehensive curriculum of dance and dance-related classes taught by professionals. Students take a variety of classes including ballet, pointe, contemporary, jazz/hip hop, tap, modern, composition/choreography, Pilates mat, yoga and nutrition. Dancers attend camp daily, 10:30am-4:45pm and may choose a 2, 3, 4 or 5-week option. The program culminates with an in-studio showcase on July 27.
